Rules for the Bowler of the Year Scholarship Tournament

1. Check In: Check in time for the squad is 30 minutes prior to the scheduled bowling time.
2. All bowlers are expected to wear neat and appropriate attire. No hats may be worn during competition. The tournament director reserves the right to ask any bowler to change out of inappropriate attire or be disqualified.
3. Eligibility: Capital Area USBC youth members who have bowled in a 2009-2010 certified youth league and have minimum of 15 games.
4. Averages: Bowler's will use their highest 2009-2010 league average as of March 19, 2010 for this tournament. A minimum of 15 games must have been bowled by the average cut off date. **If your center runs a split season please include standing sheets from the league ending in December for average verification.**
5. Handicap: Handicap per game will be 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and a scratch basis of 220.
6. Entry Fee: The cost of the tournament is \$11.00 and will be divided as follows: \$6.50 lineage, \$2.25 scholarship and \$ 2.25 awards/expenses. Scholarship will be managed through SMART- Account # 8854 - **smart@bowl.com or call 800.514.2695, x8290 or x8292.**
7. Tardy Rule: Any player arriving late will begin play with score to begin counting in the frame bowled. Each frame missed will receive a zero.
8. Entry Closing Date: Completed entry forms and appropriate fees must be postmarked no later than March 29, 2010. No refunds will be given after the entry closing date.
9. Squad time: There will be one squad Saturday, April 10 at 1:00pm.
10. Format: Each participant will bowl 3 games including handicap to determine position standings.
11. Awards: Trophies/plaques will be presented at the conclusion of the tournament for 1st and 2nd places (male and female) in each age division.
12. Capital Area USBCA will donate \$10.00 per bowler to the scholarship portion of the tournament. This amount is divided up based upon the percentage of prize fund that is proportional to the number of entries among the divisions. \$100.00 of the money donated by the Capital Area USBC Association will be divided equally (\$50.00 each) for the highest female scratch series and the highest male scratch series(regardless of their division). If a bowler places in their division and bowls the highest series, they may win both place scholarship money and the scratch scholarship money.
13. Scholarship money collected will be kept within that division.
14. Scholarship monetary awards will be based on gender. All other awards are based upon divisions and gender. The divisions are listed on the front of this form.
15. Scholarship awards will be based upon a 1:10 ratio or major fraction thereof, but a minimum of 1 female and 1 male in each division will be awarded scholarships.
16. If a bowler does not show, the prize fund money paid by that bowler will stay within that division but the lineage fee will be returned to the Capital Area USBC Association.
17. This is a USBC sanctioned tournament. All USBC rules will apply.
18. The decision of the tournament director shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC rule 329.
19. Confirmations will not be sent, but a list of participants will be posted on the website by April 5, 2010.
